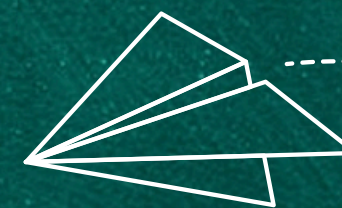
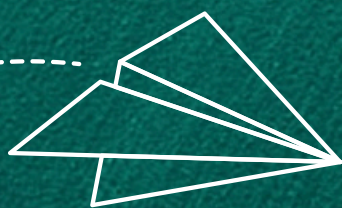

# Welcome to our school

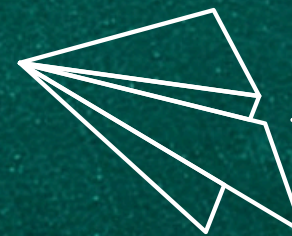


Welcome to Huntingdon House School.

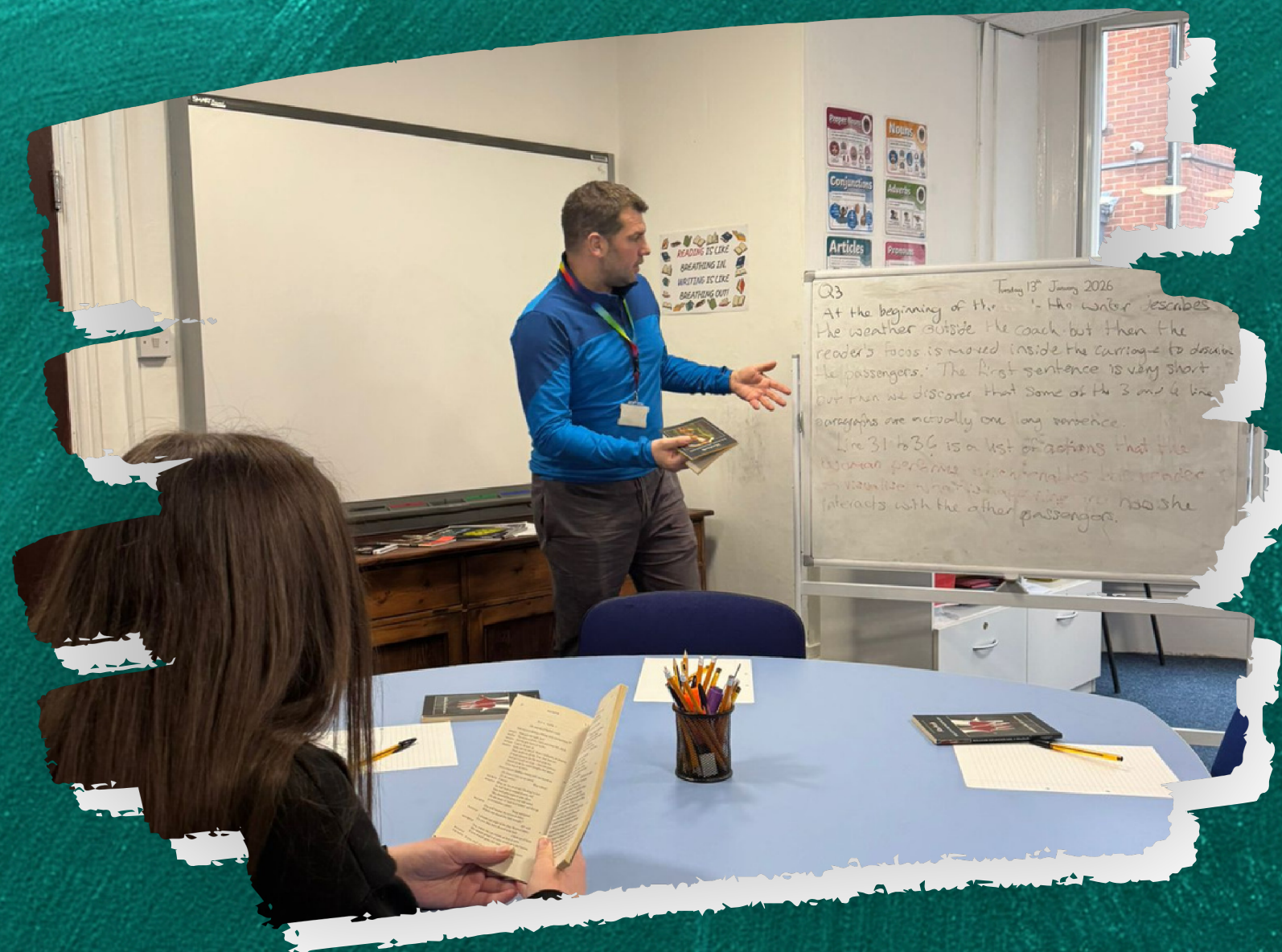




# OUR PURPOSE

We focus on developing the whole person, promoting independence, confidence and a strong sense of self-worth through meaningful learning experiences.

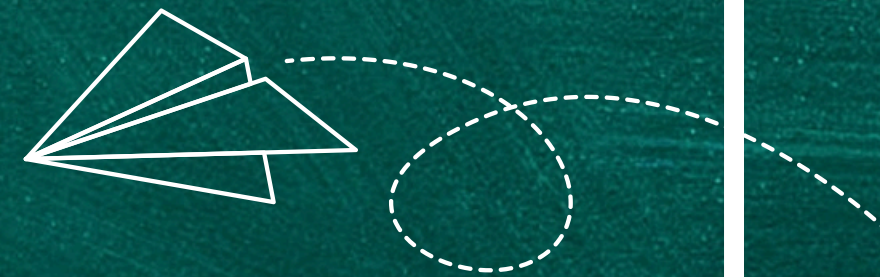

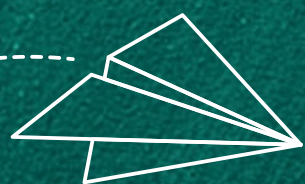


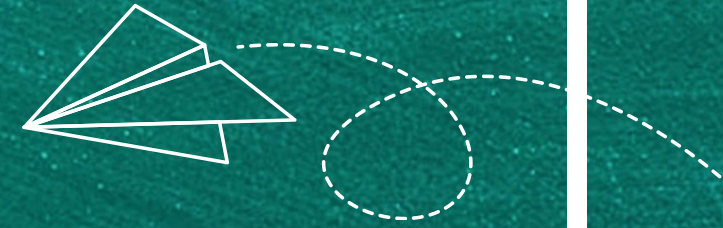
# OUR CURRICULUM

Learning is practical, engaging and linked to real-life experiences, helping students to build confidence and independence.



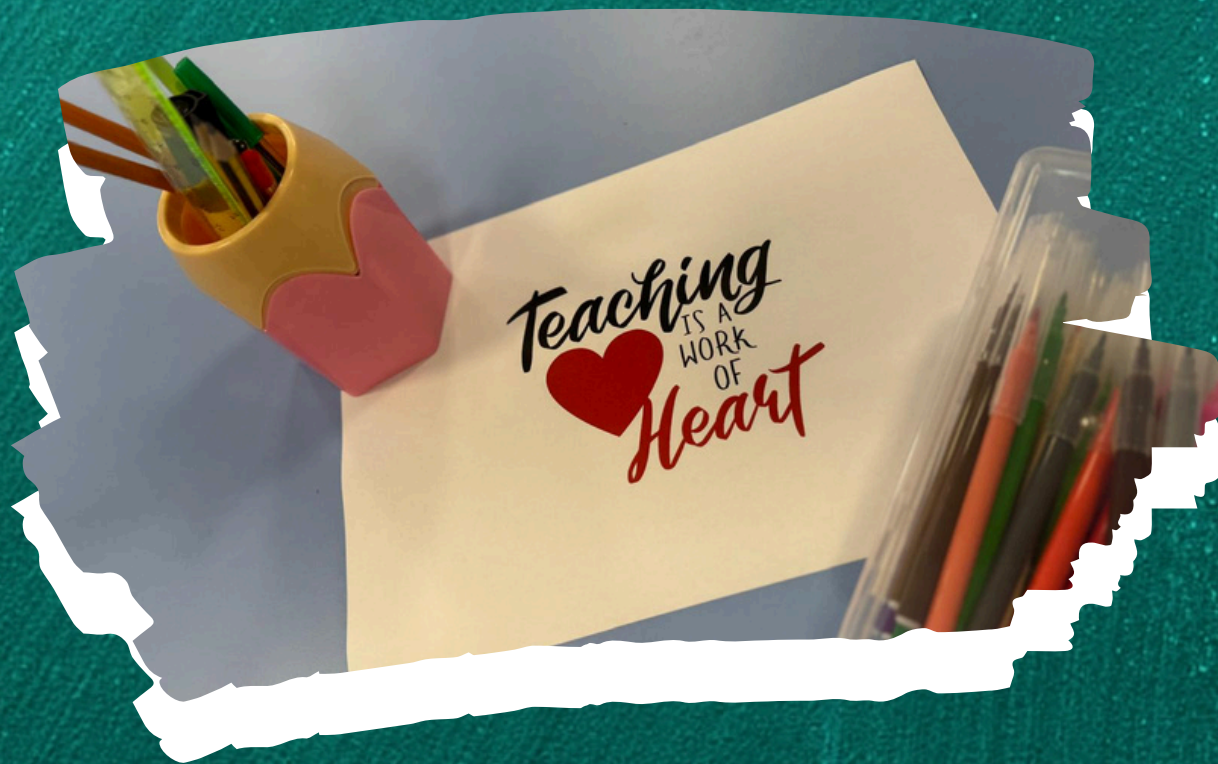


# Admissions
